**Dates:** 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> February – children attend one of these days

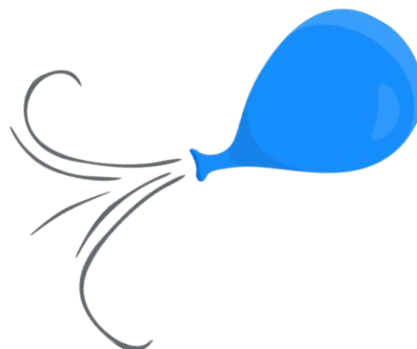
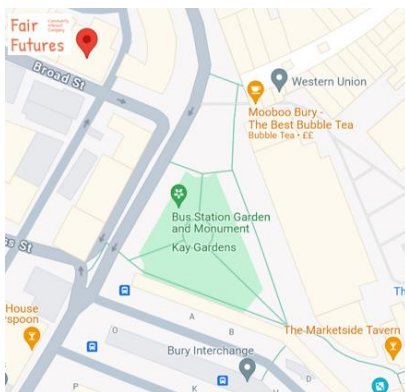
